The role

The Chief of Staff drives cross-functional collaboration and serves as a key strategic partner to the CEO, ensuring the organization's mission and growth priorities are effectively executed. This role oversees and coordinates high-impact initiatives across the organization, including strategic planning, funder cultivation, and advisory board management and leads special projects that advance organizational growth and mission impact.

Your key responsibilities

- Strategic Direction and Growth: As a member of the leadership team, contribute to the development of Learning Heroes' future strategy and direction. Actively participate in Learning Heroes' weekly strategy meetings and lead the planning of executive team meetings and strategic planning sessions/retreats. Serve as a thought partner to the leadership team on organizational strategy, culture, and operational challenges. Stay abreast of learnings and insights from across the education field that can help shape the direction of Learning Heroes' growth and strategic direction.
- Grants & Development: With an eye towards long-term sustainability of the
 organization, work closely with the leadership team on fundraising and development,
 including: drafting, editing, and submitting concept papers, grants, proposals, and
 scopes of work; supporting ongoing relationships and communications with current and
 prospective funders; tracking grant metrics, expenditures, and work performed against
 grants; and ensure submission of compelling and timely reporting of grant-related
 obligations.
- Advisory Board: Working closely with the leadership team, coordinate Advisory Board meetings, materials, and follow-up actions to help ensure Learning Heroes optimizes the contributions of advisory board members to inform the future of the organization.
 Support recruitment, onboarding and ongoing engagement of board members.
- Project Management of Strategic Initiatives: Manage special projects and crossfunctional initiatives, as needed and directed by the CEO. Coordinate internal communication and ensure leadership alignment on priorities and decisions. Identify process improvements to increase organizational efficiency and effectiveness.
